

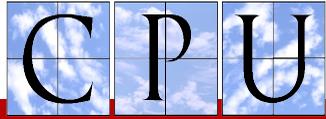

Reformation Class (Second 6-weeks only)

In this course we shall examine and celebrate the great recovery of the gospel of Jesus Christ effected during the Reformation of the 16th century. We shall give attention to the great figures of that remarkable era, including especially Huldrych Zwingli, Martin Luther, and John Calvin along with the great Biblical doctrines they recovered, especially that core of gospel truth—justification by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone, on the basis of the witness and authority of the Bible alone. We shall also give attention to the revolutionary impact of the Reformation upon the place or preaching, understanding of the Christian life, and of the church. Before we are finished we shall also ask concerning the state of Reformation theology today and its relevance for contemporary communities of faith.
