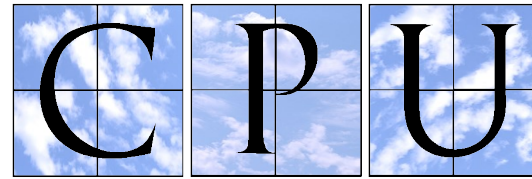

How do I choose a class?

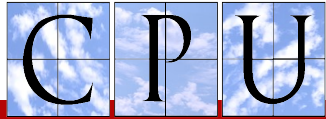

The Five Love Languages of Teenagers by Gary Chapman focuses on the parent-teen relationship. Teenagers are going through tremendous transitions socially, emotionally, and physically. Gary Chapman offers so much insight on dealing effectively with teens.
