

In accordance with the vision of CrossPoint, the purpose of CrossPoint Missions is to reach **JUST ONE MORE** by partnering with gospel-centered ministries locally, domestically, and internationally in sharing the message and love of Jesus Christ with a lost world. CrossPoint Missions are grounded in these Biblical convictions:

1. The ultimate goal of missions is the eternal glorification of God by all people groups on earth.

2022 Missions Year In Review

2022 HIGHLIGHTS

- 131 CrossPointers traveled internationally or domestically on short-term mission trips to 8 different countries on 4 continents.
- Commissioned Brandon & Mallory Lenzi for a mid-term mission trip to Thailand, Vietnam, and Japan.
- CrossPoint supported new church plants in Germany and Atlanta and began discussions with new partners in Canada, India, and Israel.
- Assisted with various needs of our mission partners around the world (including a medical clinic in Peru, a Bible translation office in Papa New Guinea, a women's ministry in Lebanon, and a food bank in Romania).
- **50** CrossPoint students participated in a serve day with The WellHouse, The Lovelady Center, Stitches of Grace, Serving You Ministries, and Alabama Baptist Children's Homes.
- Through a new mission partnership, CrossPoint hosted its first Guidelight Retreat for families impacted by childhood disability.
- CrossPointers packed **1,270** Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes and collected a total of **3,194** shoeboxes serving as an area collection site.
- CrossPointers gave over \$390,000 to the Missions Stream (breakdown below).

Missions Stream Goal

GOAL FOR 2023

At CrossPoint we seek to serve the Lord through a missional approach to ministry. In other words, we look outward instead of inward. This is reflected in our giving as mission endeavors are funded through all three streams of CrossPoint's river of stewardship (i.e. Ministry Stream, Manna Stream, and Missions Stream). In 2022, your generosity allowed us to invest over \$1.2 million in missions and ministries around the globe. As the Lord wills, we pray that that number only increases in 2023. While we are missional with our Ministry and Manna Streams, the **Missions Stream** is 100% dedicated to sharing God's message and love around the world. In 2023, we have set a goal of \$425,000 for the Missions Stream, which would constitute the highest total given to this Stream in CrossPoint's history. Praise God from whom all blessings flow!

Amounts given to the Missions Stream are allocated 40% to the International Mission Board's Lottie Moon Offering, 25% to the North American Mission Board's Annie Armstrong Offering, and 35% to CrossPoint Direct Missions. CrossPoint Direct Missions giving has been utilized historically to provide support to our direct mission partners, supplement mission trip costs through scholarships and meet needs and opportunities that arise related to our various mission endeavors (see page 3 for more detailed information on Direct Missions allocations). It is truly amazing to see what God is doing through your generosity to the Missions Stream.

As a member of CrossPoint, you have the flexibility to give to the **Missions Stream** at your own pace. You can give weekly, monthly, or even annually to support these exciting mission opportunities based on your personal cash flow patterns. You can also teach your family to generously give. What an opportunity we have a church family and what an opportunity you have as an individual or as a family to join God where He is working at home and around the world! Pray about what God would have you give to Missions in 2023!

The opportunities to engage with our Mission Partners face-to-face, to encourage them and to serve alongside them are ever-expanding. Many of you have had the blessing of going on mission for the sake of the gospel. Others are curious but are not sure where to begin. Here are several ways to go on mission:



Short-Term Mission Team Leader: The Leader has been actively involved in missions historically and feels led to take on a leadership role with one of our existing mission teams or to lead a new endeavor. The mission Leader's primary responsibility is to disciple and pray for those on your mission team. The Leader is also responsible for recruiting and training team members, working with the Minister of Missions and Mission Partner to finalize trip logistics, preparing the team for the trip, supervising the team while on the field, ensuring the financial responsibilities of the team are met and documented, and reporting on the trip upon the team's return.

Short-Term Mission Team Member – The Member may or may not have missions experience, but acknowledges the Biblical calling to take the gospel to the nations. All Team Members are expected to prayerfully seek to live out their CrossPoint Membership Covenant while on mission.

Mission Point Partner – Point Partners actively support CrossPoint's Mission Partners and Short-Term Mission Teams through prayer and encouragement. Point Partners are responsible for maintaining regular contact with our Mission Partners and actively encouraging them through cards, notes, emails, etc.



Mission Field in Your Home

As we celebrate the work of God around the globe during this year's Missions Expo, I'd like us to ponder how we might reach JUST ONE MORE with the gospel right in our own homes. As adoptive parents, when my wife, Lindsey, and I joined the church early in 2020, we knew there had to be others that were involved in foster care and adoption and we wanted to explore. We wondered, "how were the people of CrossPoint inspired, connected, and supported in the work of caring for the orphan?" After all, caring for the orphan is foundational to the Christian faith. **James** 1:27 savs, "Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit widows orphans and in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world."



Caring for the orphan is one of our callings as the Church. Think about it. What better way is there to fulfill the Great Commission than welcoming a child into your family and bringing them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord? This is not to say that we should neglect the other biblical responsibilities given to the people of God, but I believe we should be known particularly for this work that so closely resembles the gospel. However, I have to admit, foster care and adoption seem to be somewhat of an "alternative lifestyle" even in the Church. Should it be this way? What if, instead of seeing Christian families who foster and adopt as unique, we all saw foster care and adoption as normal?


So, after much prayer, we decided to start a small group with three main goals: to grow in community with God and one another, to use our gifts to build up the body of Christ and serve the community, and to connect the people of God to the foundational ministry of serving the orphan. We named our group Adopting Love as God's love toward us is an adopting love. Furthermore, as God's adopted children we have the incredible privilege of demonstrating this love to others. I believe the families and individuals of CrossPoint have tremendous opportunity to step into the work of caring for the orphan to make a significant impact for the Kingdom in our local community. Today, there approximately 6,000 children in foster care in the state of Alabama, but only 2,300 licensed foster homes in the state. It's easy to see the need in these numbers. Seeing this need, churches like CrossPoint have an opportunity to step into this arena and have a substantial reflect this impact. As vou on opportunity, let me dispel the myth about being a foster or adoptive parent. not reserved for extraordinary It's persons. If you're equipped to be a parent, then you're equipped to be a foster or adoptive parent. It doesn't take an extraordinary person or family to answer the call to foster or adopt, just a willing one.

Now I ask you to consider how you might turn your home into a mission field through adoption, fostering or becoming a respite care home. My prayer is that God would use CrossPoint to reach the most vulnerable in our society. May we, in our God-given standing as His adopted children, embrace the calling to serve the orphan in our community.

When I was asked to take the position of Executive Director of The WellHouse, I said yes because I saw it as a true ministry opportunity! Because this nonprofit ministry was founded faith-based Christian organization, church partnerships have been critical to the growth and effectiveness, and even survival of the work. These many partners have not only supported The WellHouse with their generous monetary donations, but, equally as important, support has flowed through prayer and volunteers who minister in many ways from long term mentoring of a survivor of human trafficking to the building and maintenance of the 63 acres on which the beautiful campus is housed.

Indeed, that has been a focus for me not only for those we serve but also for our committed staff. And, along with the influence of our wonderful church partners, we have seen true transformation

However, there were other issues that I had not considered. One day a dear volunteer and CrossPoint member asked if she could come meet with me. Even as I said yes, I felt that angst that comes when someone asks for what seems to be a very serious conversation. I shall never forget what she said, "I am worried that you all do not know how to fight spiritual warfare"!

And, she was right! Here I was thinking that I had accepted the opportunity of a lifetime! Where my calling to love and help the hurting also allowed me the privilege of sharing Jesus. I just knew everyone would gladly receive Him and we would rejoice forevermore. But, just as that wise volunteer noted, I had not factored in the fact that spiritual warfare was abundant and was never going to let up! And why? Well, our ministry seeks to offer freedom and restoration from the most egregious evil imaginable where those thought to be hopeless and forever lost are finding new life.

The enemy hates what we do, and he shows up in the most unusual and unexpected ways. We often feel we are on a dual track of offering the best of services along with spiritual renewal while fighting the attacks of evil. For me personally, I had never known the depth of attacks that I was to experience, and I had never experienced such deep pain while also growing abundantly in my faith. Indeed, joy and sadness can indeed co-exist.

As a believer in Christ, however, I know that nothing happens to those who are His without His allowing it. And, so, a term I adopted shortly after beginning this journey, "total dependence on God," has become more real and more a way of life than I could have imagined. Along with this has come the realization that the family of God is incredible and without support from those who are also His, we simply cannot navigate these dark waters and heavy trials. And, we have so many with whom to celebrate the great victories!

In conclusion, I have been privileged to see lives changed and souls brought to light from the darkest of places. I will forever be grateful to our church partners, and I love these people like family – well, they are family! I am especially thankful for my CrossPoint family! Heaven will be so very sweet!
