Regardless, we have always tried to be good stewards of our money.

When my father died in 1992, my mother asked my brother and Ron to make her a budget based on her new income. She had one caveat, however. She wanted to be able to tithe, and she tithed faithfully until the

day she died. She was also very generous to additional needs and projects at her church.

When Mother died, we put her house on the market. We never dreamed that it would sell for the asking price, but it did. And we never realized the value of the inheritance from her estate. I knew after I received my portion of the inheritance, I wanted to tithe it. I had never had that much personal money, and I wanted to

manage it responsibly.

Ron offered to give my inheritance tithe electronically, because it would be quicker and more efficient. I had a different idea, however. I wanted to give it personally. After securing a tithe envelope from a hallway kiosk, I wrote my inheritance tithe check and deposited it back into the same kiosk. It felt so good to personally write the check and bring it personally to the church.

Ron and I don't have any dramatic stories to tell about how this happened or that happened because we chose to tithe all these

years, but we are blessed beyond measure.



#### TEACHING OUR CHILDREN TO GIVE

Our girls, Scarlett, Penelope, & Macie Jo, have recently been working around the house and earning what we call "commission." Nathan and I felt the need to teach them how to earn and work for what they have. We are doing this, in part, to avoid the rampant desire for entitlement.

Their jobs include taking out trash, folding laundry, making their beds, cleaning their rooms, unloading the dishwasher, and so on. They earn anywhere from 25 cents to \$1.00 for a task. We are doing this to teach them about tithing, saving and spending.

As we prepared for Harvest Day last year, Nathan and I wanted our children to understand the importance of giving to the kingdom of God. Nathan explained it to them on their level. We gave each one of them the



opportunity to choose how much of their commission that they wanted to give to God. We taught them the total needed to be at least 10% of their commission. God worked mightily through our kids. Scarlett gave \$2.00 (over 10%), Macie Jo gave \$2.00 (over 10%), and Penelope gave all that she earned, \$10.35!

We are so thankful for our children who want to bless the kingdom of God, and for a church that ministers to and pours into our family. We are so blessed to be a part of CrossPoint. God is doing mighty things in and through our church, and it's such an honor to be able to participate in that.

#### GOD ALWAYS COMES THROUGH Jeff & Jo Cook

In 2016, we began planning for Grant to attend college in the fall of 2017. We immediately began stressing and worrying about how we would be able to make this happen. We wanted to put our kids through college without borrowing money.

Two of my best friends, who already had kids in college, assured me that it would work out. They told me how it never makes sense on paper, but that God would provide

a way. Even though I knew this in my heart, it still worried me.

We have always given to the church, and we have always been blessed to give above and beyond our tithe. However, in November of 2016, things were different, and we

began discussing our options.

We considered giving only our tithe while we put the kids through college, but that didn't seem like a viable option for us. Every year we had been able to give a little more. After much prayer and discussion, we took a leap of faith and decided to increase our giving. We reminded one another of how God has always been faithful to us and that's what we needed to do. We turned in our cards that Sunday, and it was a done deal.

Grant had taken several ACT tests and had done well enough to receive some scholarship money. Yet, we were waiting on two remaining scores. I VIVIDLY recall what happened the morning of Tuesday, November 8, 2016. I was studying a series on the book of Joshua. It was day 16 of the study, and the title was "Joshua's Inheritance." As usual, I always took notes, and across the top of my page I wrote, "God ALWAYS comes through!!"

After completing my study, I checked to see if they had posted Grant's ACT scores. I said a quick prayer, closed my eyes, and hit the button to view his scores. After a few seconds, I literally, one by one, peeled each finger from covering my eyes...in TOTAL

disbelief and as ONLY God could do...the composite score was 32!!!!

In that moment, I knew a 32 would earn Grant a scholarship to Alabama, and it would earn him a full engineering scholarship that would include even more money. His college tuition was paid for in full!

Here is our lesson: God didn't allow Grant to have the scholarship because we increased our giving. Grant is extremely smart and the fact that he got that score didn't surprise me. We share our story because we know that God is FAITHFUL!!! He WILL

provide if you completely trust Him!!!

Do things always go our way? Maybe not, but it will always work out His way, which is His

plan for you.

The verse that IMMEDIATELY came to my mind was Ephesians 3:20-21, which reads, "God is able to do exceedingly, abundantly, above all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work in us, to him be the glory in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever! Amen."
